We signed the contract, moved most of the things and held our first service there with Bro. Dan preaching before he left for the states.

There has been a definite increase in the enthusiasm of the people, a closer fellowship, and visitors have begun to come to our services. There is now a classroom for the children for Sunday School, and a lot more work to be done preparing it to be more presentable. A group of men from the church in Limeira will be spending two days there painting, putting up a sign, lights, and other necessities. What a blessing and help that will be for us.

The church in Limeira continues to move forward. Visitors are coming, 11 have been saved since January and God is working with a great and powerful hand. Some have come desiring to change their lives and express a desire to do that which is right in the sight of the Lord, but not with a perfect heart, so to our disappointment have turned back. Also some young people that have made wrong choices in the past, now wish they could change to do what's right, but they're not willing to make the right decisions to do that. On the other side of things we rejoice in those who have made wrong decisions in the past but have repented and are now giving everything to the Lord. Keep praying for the work in Limeira. I believe that God is going to do many wonderful things through that revived church.

Pray for us concerning the Lord's will in all these things in the near future. Pr. Dan Bennett is planning to return from furlough to take his church in Osasco in September. Also the Deaf Bible Institute will be finishing it's classes in June and as it appears we will not have students to continue at that time. We should be graduating two deaf students in December, the Lord willing.

Even though the economic crisis is around the world, our GOD has been so good to us by supplying our needs as He has promised through your gracious giving. Thank you so much for being faithful in financial support and holding us up before the throne of grace. Let us all keep on till HE comes or takes us to glory to be with Him.
